

DRUMBEAT Social Development Program (PHODR)

Assessment Criteria

The School Curriculum and Assessment Authority (SCAA) has recognised the DRUMBEAT Social Development Program as an endorsed program for the equivalent of one unit contributing to WACE requirements.

To gain accreditation, students must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

- 75% attendance of 20 hours (20x1hr) DRUMBEAT Sessions to be delivered by an accredited DRUMBEAT Facilitator (recorded in Portfolio)
- Complete 12 in-class reflection activities (12 hours)
- 8 hours of instrument practice, in class or at home (recorded in Portfolio)
- 20 hours of performance preparation (recorded in Portfolio)
- 75% pass rate of 4 Social Understanding Questionnaires (recorded in Portfolio)
- Compose a rhythm (3 part harmony)
- Construction of a drum and evidence e.g. photos, research/planning, concept drawings, etc.
- Participate in at least one performance and performance reflection

Portfolios are submitted to Holyoake for assessment by the deadline. Holyoake will provide certificates of achievement to the school and the school must report the achievement to the Authority.
